Re: Changemakers Project at Cledford Lagoons

The Science and Geography Departments would like to invite your child to participate in a new project called 'Changemakers'. This is a collaborative project with Green Earth Developments Group who have reached out to our school to ask for our help and support in rewilding the Cledford Lagoons in Middlewich. To kick-start this collaborative project, we would like to take participating students to visit the Cledford Lagoons on **Monday 7th October**. The day will start in school with a briefing from the Green Earth Developments Group during Lesson 1 (09:05). After this session, we will walk to the Lagoons, which is approximately a 25 minute walk. Once reaching the Cledford Lagoons, the students will receive more information about the land and the project, as well as having the opportunity to walk around the site and start to build our vision. We will then walk back to school, in time for lunch at 13:35.

Clothing and Equipment

As we will be outdoors and walking around the site, your child can wear their PE kit for the day. Please ensure they have appropriate footwear, such as trainers, and a light coat or jacket in the case of rain / cooler weather.

Please ensure that your child brings any medication required and a completed medical authorisation form, obtainable from the school reception. Asthma inhalers must be brought by pupils.

We will return to school in time for lunch, however students might want to bring a mid-morning snack with them to eat whilst walking to Cledford Lagoons. Students are also encouraged to bring a full reusable water bottle to keep themselves hydrated throughout the day.
