We are very pleased to continue to provide a subsidised school bus service to and from Winsford, which for the 2025/26 academic year will be ± 1018.40 for the year. Due to the high demand for this service, we are unable to offer 'occasional use', and due to limited places we will offer places on a first come, first served basis. Places are offered for the whole school year and there will be an option to pay the balance in 10 monthly instalments of ± 101.84 each.
